Jim "Cash" Proffitt's Roadrunners have lost fifteen of their last twenty games; however, they recently won three in a row from the first-place Outlaws.

The Roadrunners pitching staff's leader in wins is reliever Stan Belinda, with six wins. Lee Smith has 24 saves.

Hitting leader for the Roadrunners is Luis Polina, who currently has a 22 game hitting streak and is hitting around .280.

Kevin Maas, in 191 at bats, has 23 homers, averaging a homerun for every 8.3 AB's.
